LCDR Reyes previously served as a medical officer in the Division of Dermatology and Dental Products (DDDP) within CDER, where she began her Commissioned Corps career. As a medical officer in DDDP, she worked to promote the development of treatments for dermatologic conditions, ensure the safe conduct of clinical trials, and analyze new drug applications for FDA approval.

LCDR Reyes continues to educate medical students and residents as an Assistant Professor in the Department of Dermatology at the Uniformed Service University for the Health Sciences. She has deployed in support of Remote Area Medical's Operation Lone Star in 2019 and more recently has deployed supporting the USPHS COVID19 response
