LT Evan Williams is a pharmacist in the USPHS Ready Reserve. He is one of the original 11 reservists to commission with OBC Class 128/01. Serving in Region 9 out of Henderson, NV, he joined the Commissioned Officers Association of the U.S. Public Health Service in July 2021.

In his civilian role, Dr. Williams is Associate Professor of Pharmacy Practice and Director of Accreditation at the Roseman University of Health Sciences College of Pharmacy in Henderson, NV. He practices clinically at Valley Hospital Medical Center, a community teaching hospital located in downtown Las Vegas, NV, where he provides clinical pharmacy services with a focus in transitions of care, precepts residents and students, and serves on their residency advisory committee

Dr. Williams received a Doctor of Pharmacy from the University of Arizona and is board certified in pharmacotherapy and ambulatory care. He received his MBA from Husson University.

Dr. Williams has been awarded the Nevada Volunteer Recognition Certificate for COVID Vaccination Efforts from the Office of the Governor of Nevada, has been twice named Teacher of the Year, and was a nominee for the ASHP Foundation Pharmacy Practice Research Award. He was also an NJCAA Track and Field Academic All-American.
